<u>Landing-Page.html#</u>); was lunched at an ONC meeting. Complementing to JIC, not overlapping. GCeHI has mainly the task to communicate, outreach. WSU sees opportunities for collaboration between GCeHI and JIC.

DNE warns that our industry does not develop duplicate groups.

SAB asks about HSC's role (healthstandardscollaborative.org) towards JIC and the other initiatives mentioned. HSC is a kind of a national JIC such as in Netherlands in other countries. WSU suggests we organize links to national/local JICs such as the US and find out where such local initiatives exist today. This proposition is supported by MNU. This will be an action item for the short term, also since JIC should stimulate local collaborations.

SAB comments the discussion slide she prepared. SDO have obvious roles, such as producing, publishing and maintaining standards. They deliver further users' guides, or Q&A. What about specific requirements such as delivering standards in alternate formats, API, keep access to older versions, mappings or translations? Certification for end users? How do SDO handle incorrect implementation/use of standards, etc?

MNU underlines importance of standards use -international as well as national, as a mean to influence wider implementations. For DSW rather than inventing a document, JIC should first establish a questionnaire/survey for each SDO to capture what is done, what not, what is common to some or all SDO. How we address then lessons learned, incorrect implementation/use. RST and DNE point to some work done by ISO TC 215 / WG3.

SAB and CHA to work on a questionnaire (adoption, use and maintenance) which will be discussed in the Executive council and later food for a position paper – the views of the SDOs.

6. Common data exchange format for COVID-19 related epidemiological dataRST

RST reports about the responses to 3 questions raised at our last Executive council:

- a) Are you aware of existing standards or initiatives for voluntary public reporting of COVID-19 epidemiological data that can be (re)used?
- b) Are you willing and able to participate in a global standardization effort to quickly publish a proposed standard format?
- c) Who should we contact within your organization to get more background information to prepare for our engagement with JRC (joint research center for EU)?

Responses from LOINC, SNOMED International about their own activities in this field, GS1 establishing contact with WHO, ISO TC 215 and HL7 International pointing to projects such as SHIELD, SAMER and N3C (national COVID cohort collaborative) all three being national initiatives.

Any additional input would be welcomed.

MNU comments this agenda item which full title is "SDO Collaboration, Artifact Maintenance, Harmonization and Synchronization". This is sourced in JIC's role in our ecosystem. Successful collaboration has been reported in our White Paper; but the issue of collaboratively developed standards' maintenance is not transparently addressed -a lot relies on individual experts' commitments. Example is taken from the IPS, where 5 SDOs played complementing roles, but have different maintenance processes. Can we formalize this maintenance process? In a project base, coordinated by JIC or coordinated by a specific new group?

DSW: We have a role to play as a group, we have a duty towards the community. JIC has rather a facilitator/supporter than a governance or management role. Information and issues are brought to the Executive Council's attention, so action can be taken, such as communication. Complementing the communication effort, JIC constituents shall collect feedback from their stakeholders.

RHA and others confirm that current projects such as IPS have been successful thank to individual experts' continuous engagement. The present discussion is very important, and we have to define what JIC's role is / shall be for coordinated maintenance.

SNOMED International offers for the IPS maintenance coordination support [confluence, with documentation where changes have been recognized by other SDOs, respectively shared with them] and resources [IPS virtual community space].

This agenda item is tabled and will be discussed further at the next JIC Executive council. CHA will prepare discussion material with MNU and DSW.

8. Guideline for rapid standards development across organizations in emergent situationsRST/SAB/all

RST presents what ISO provides as a solution for rapid development of "publicly available standards" (PAS). He explains the CEN solution (workshop agreement).

Not every SDO disposes of such tools to meet urgent needs, but several SDO have been able to provide standards in a particularly short period of time.

This information from ISO will be considered in the work decided on point 5 above. CHA to collaborate with SAB and ALA on this.
