1. Welcome, roll call, apologies..... UKR

4. Update and discussion on JIC communication

PNE presents.

Joint mailing letter from the Chair is unanimously approved.

JIC event (proposition for February) raises strong support. We do not need a long event -may be one hour- must not be perfect, may be a panel; SDO activities to be show-cased (but participation not limited to JIC SDO); at some stage we may use break-out rooms to discuss special topics; we may pre-record sessions and run only the discussion live. We may repeat this every second month. If all JIC SDO's communicate on this we will certainly reach a wide audience; that is further material for our social media communication. Recording of our events to be posted on our website. Whilst we have thoughts regarding our target audience, we shall not be limitative and mostly wide open to interested parties.

Discussions with local JIC may provide also material for such "JIC events".

Another idea is to interact in the eHealth week (Europe), which 2021 will be hosted by Portugal (and Portugal is very much interested in international standards).

MGL mentions the appetite for international standards, illustrated by a talk by ISO's secretary General to the G20, where he quoted one of TC 215's work item (Reference standards portfolio – public health preparedness and response – information system – which addresses global COVID-19 information management). He further presented on international standards in a break-out session next to the UN General Assembly.

Decision and Action item: each Executive member to send propositions for topics with possible speakers to CHA within 10 days.

PNE and UKR invite JIC Executive council to the coming GS1 Healthcare Summit, taking place the following week. CHA to send invitation to all.

5. Update on pending businesses

ONC/GDHP proposed a date for a follow-up meeting but that did not meet availabilities on our side. We are still searching a date.

6. Linkages to local joint initiatives

Engaging first with one local JIC, in a separate call, to understand their needs and what they would like to offer to the JIC. The local JIC stakeholders may be happy to refer to and engage with JIC, this might offer for allan easier or stronger communication possibility with local ministries.

Decision: JIC to organize a side meeting with one local JIC -Austria to start with.

7. Collaboration between JIC and other standard related organisations

EHA raises attention to the Academy established by IMIA (<https://imia-medinfo.org/wp/iahsi>), which groups high profile people from governments and academies (Task Force “Current landscape of standards for digital health”). We may interact with this group, to educate (!) or expose what SDOs working with JIC are providing to the global community (a possible work topic would be the design of an international immunization file, as part of the IPS).

JOW proposes organizations such as [C-Path](#), [COMET](#), [NCI-EVS](#), [ICHOM](#), which which CDISC collaborates.

MNU proposes the Global Consortium for eHealth Interoperability, DNE the GH4GA, RST the MedDRA, EDQM, WHO-UMC and I~HD (with which there is already collaboration within UNICOM), as well as OHDSI, Orphanet, GoFAIR

For EHA, engaging East (Asia, India, Japan for example) is something really important and we are not enough paying attention to this region.

Decision: continue the discussion to define actions at one next meeting.

8. Discussion paper on xSDO collaboration

KSA presents the slide deck prepared with MNU and RHA. The group, which uses IPS as an example, comes to points for JIC, such as

- Provide technical infrastructure (registry of changes in the pipeline, etc.; host a registry of implementations [state of Myanmar has recently adopted a set of IHE/FHIR standards for their national IPS -that should be an accessible information])
- Develop global awareness

- Promote development, adoption and recognition
