1. Welcome, roll call, apologies

Several Executive Council members echoed these thanks. The retirement of "Mr. IPS" will be progressive, and all look forward interacting with SKA.

3. Agenda approval, requests for other/new business

4. JIC communication: openForum 9 December 2021

Our program committee is warmly thanked by UKR and colleagues.

Total registrations for this openForum exceeded 300 persons. About half of them participated to the webinar. Interesting representation for APAC, even in the second session (5.00 pm CET).

PNE exposes communication impact about this 3rd openForum, noting that data will continue to evolve. We notice today at lunch time an interesting growth of followers (Twitter, Linkedin).

JIC website to be updated soon, with links to the recordings and more.

Outcome from the openForum will be captured in a report, which will serve to increase again JIC's visibility. An email will be sent to the registered visitors to our openForum, to raise their awareness on the recordings, etc.

5. Continuation of discussion about new member

All SDO have now signed the Disclosure paper required by WHO. That will be forwarded immediately to our contacts to unlock the process.

Observer status: to be captured in an amendment to our Charter. The observer shall have the same role as other JIC members, except for the voting right. From the discussion it is noted that this amendment shall be precisely prepared for an application such as from WHO. It shall not open the door to further applications. It remains possible to the JIC to revise this clause when circumstances require. RDH and CHA will prepare the amendment and share it with the JIC Executive Council for approbation by circulation.

Code of conduct: the revised document has been sent to the JIC Executive council on 26 November 2021; DSW expressed his approval. No further comment expressed in this meeting; a vote takes place: every SDO approves the code of conduct (CDISC was not represented). The approved document will be published asap on JIC's website.

It will be sent to our applicant from openEHR with the questions listed at the October meeting.

6. Update on pending businesses:

JIC has developed a very positive relationship with GDHP, which was testified by several GDHP representatives during today's openForum (including the incoming GDHP chair).

JIC will maintain this relationship with GDHP, including with the openForum report (see above) and any further possibilities.

7. SAMD and ISO TF 5 / IHE and other standards

This subject is brought by MNU who noticed that there are uncertainties and possible overlaps between SDOs working in this domain. SAMD is a regulatory defined concept, which is in the scope of ISO/TC 215 JWG7, but as well in other SDOs, including IHE and GS1.

It is requested that JIC constituents prepare information about their work on this domain for the January Executive council – MNU has the lead on preparation.

8. Report on xSDO collaboration

The new IPS website (<u>www.international-patient-summary.net</u>) has been launched during the openForum, and each SDO is invited to inform about and promote this new tool to help interested parties, adopters and implementers.
